- Scroll down the left side to "Demographic Update"
- You must provide at least one "Parent/Guardian Contact" and one "Emergency Contact."
- Open the documents and click "I Accept" (Student Handbook/Tech Agreement...)
- Registration is complete after you sign electronically and hit "submit."
- Check the website for a list of teachers and the start/end times for each class.
